

Tips for cleaning products

1. All-purpose or universal cleaner:

- Suitable for cleaning most surfaces including floors.
- Please do not use on wood as it contains surfactants. There are special cleaning agents for wood.
- In addition to the all-purpose cleaner, baking soda is also suitable for many areas of the household.

2. vinegar cleaner or anti-limescale agent:

- Indispensable against limescale deposits in all areas where a lot of water is used, i.e. on shower walls, washbasins / sinks, tiles, taps etc.
- Vinegar cleaner can be diluted depending on the stubbornness of the limescale residue.
- If no glass cleaner is available, it can also be used to clean mirrors.

3. toilet cleaner & toilet brush:

- Toilet cleaner sticks to the inside of the toilet bowl and removes deposits most effectively after 15-20 minutes.
- The bottle should have a curved neck to reach under the rim of the toilet bowl.
- The brush can be used to scrub away dirt - the lower rim should not be forgotten here either.

4. detergent for dishes:

- Despite the dishwasher, a hand dishwashing detergent, sponge and brush should always be available. In addition to the dishes, most surfaces can also be cleaned with this - to avoid streaks, simply wipe with a damp cloth without detergent.
- Make sure you have enough special salt in the dishwasher, as this dissolves dirt and limescale. Without special salt, the dishes will not get properly clean, and the dishwasher will break down. There is a large screw cap on the bottom of the dishwasher. As soon as a double S lights up on the display next to the program selection, please open the screw cap, pour in the salt to just below the rim and screw the cap back on tightly.
- Rinse aid should also be refilled as soon as the symbol lights up on the display. The opening for this is on the inside of the lid next to the compartment for the dishwasher tabs/dishwasher powder. Simply open it, fill the rinse aid up to the rim and close it again.
- There is a sliding compartment next to the opening for the rinse aid. This can be filled with either dishwasher powder or a dishwasher tab before each wash cycle. For the latter, please read on the packaging whether it needs to be unpacked.

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5. additionally:

- Various cloths and sponges for wiping up stains and crumbs of all kinds. All cloths and sponges should be replaced regularly or washed at 60° and dried completely between uses, as bacteria and germs of all kinds quickly multiply in them.
- Shower squeegee against limescale stains on the shower walls. Regularly removing water from the walls after showering reduces the amount of cleaning required with anti-limescale agents. After use, limescale and soap residue should be rinsed off the squeegee with water.
- Dirt eraser with melamine resin against minor stains, especially on the walls. Moisten slightly before use and then use like an eraser. If it does not help, please report it to reception and never paint the walls yourself. Used erasers can be washed out or cut off in the affected area.
- Plunger against blockages in the pipes. A little water should be poured into the washbasin and the small opening (e.g. with a piece of damp toilet paper) should be held shut so that sufficient pressure can build up. Then place the plunger on the main opening of the pipe and pump until the blockage has been cleared - this can take several minutes!
- If required: silverfish bait, also available at reception.
- If required: anti-mold spray. If mold has formed, please remove it immediately to prevent it from spreading further and endangering your health. Mold usually develops when the room is too damp - so please always ensure proper ventilation.
